4 (a) The applicant shall contact the Division of Coastal Management (Division) and ~~complete an application form~~
5 ~~requesting approval for development. provide:~~

6 ~~(b) The applicant shall provide:~~

- 7 (1) information on site location, detailed project description, and his/her name, address and telephone number;
8 (2) a dated ~~sealed~~ plat(s) showing existing and proposed ~~development that follows the criteria outlined in 15A~~
9 ~~NCAC 7J .0203, a completed Form DCM MP 5; development;~~ and
10 (3) confirmation that:

11 (A) a written statement has been obtained and signed by the adjacent riparian property
12 owners indicating that they have no objections to the proposed work; or

13 (B) the adjacent riparian property owners have been notified by certified mail of the proposed
14 work. Such notice shall instruct adjacent property owners to provide any comments on
15 the proposed development in writing for consideration by permitting officials to the
16 Division of Coastal Management within 10 days of receipt of the notice, and, indicate
17 that no response shall be interpreted as no objection. ~~DCM~~ Division staff shall review all
18 comments. If ~~DCM~~ the Division determines that:

- 19 (i) the comments are relevant to the potential impacts of the proposed project; and
20 (ii) the permitting issues raised by the comments ~~are worthy of~~ require a more
21 detailed review, the applicant shall be notified that he/she shall submit an
22 application for a major development permit.

23 ~~(b)~~ (b) Approval of individual projects shall be acknowledged in writing by the Division of Coastal Management
24 and the applicant shall be provided a copy of this Section. Construction authorized by this permit shall be
25 completed within ~~one year~~ two years of permit issuance or the general authorization shall expire and a new permit
26 shall be required to begin or continue construction. For North Carolina Department of Transportation projects
27 identified in the Transportation Improvement Program this permit shall not expire pursuant to G.S. 136-44.7B.

28 ~~(c)~~ (c) No work shall begin until an onsite meeting is held with the applicant and a Division of Coastal Management
29 representative. Written authorization to proceed with the proposed development may be issued during this visit if
30 other approval procedure criteria have been met.
